
Faecal Immunochemical Test (FIT)



How to Complete Your Test

READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THESE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE YOU BEGIN....

Your GP requires you to complete this <u>essential test</u>. It is important that you do this <u>as soon as possible</u> and post <u>without delay</u> in the prepaid addressed envelope provided.




LABEL THE COLLECTION DEVICE

It is essential that you write your first name and surname and date of birth, using a ball point pen, on the FIT collection device label


COLLECT YOUR POO
Following the instructions on the
Fe-Col collection paper, slide the FeCol over the toilet seat to catch your
poo.



2 LABEL THE GREEN BAG
On the green bag label write your
name, date of birth AND the date that
your poo sample was taken, using a
ball point pen.



It is essential that your poo **does not come in contact with the toilet water** as this may affect the result. If this happens, **DO NOT CONTINUE**. Store your device in a cool, dry place until you have another poo. If necessary update the 'Date of Sample' on the green sample device bag.




SAMPLE YOUR POO
Unscrew the top of the FIT
collection device anti-clockwise and
remove the picker. Drag the end of
the sampling stick across the poo
sample to fill the two dimples.



PACKAGE YOUR
SAMPLE CHECK THAT
YOU HAVE
CORRECTLY LABELLED THE
SAMPLE COLLECTION DEVICE
AND GREEN

BAG. Place your completed collection device into the green plastic bag and press along the seal.



5 ENSURE CORRECT SAMPLING Make sure that the end of the stick is covered in sample but do not coat the rest of the stick. Replace the stick into the tube and twist clockwise to close securely. Only do this ONCE.



SEND YOUR SAMPLE
Place the green sample bag,
containing the sample collection
device, into the paper GP return
envelope, along with the form
provided by your GP, and seal. Return
the sealed envelope to the GP
Practice without delay.

Your test result will be returned directly to your GP within 10 days and they contact you with the result. If you have not heard from your GP within 2 please contact them. If you have any additional queries please contact your
